Navigating your world: Be prepared when leaving home

As travel guidelines and COVID-19 restrictions change, it is more important than ever to plan ahead for stress-free and relaxing outings. As someone who has had laryngectomy surgery, there are a few things you will want to consider. Whether you are going across town, across the country or across the globe, you can leave home feeling prepared and confident as you get back to traveling, doing the activities you enjoy and seeing the people you love!



What should you take with you? Always carry an emergency card and wear an alert or medical bracelet that indicates you are a neck breather when you go out. A medical bracelet can provide lifesaving information to EMS workers in an emergency. Most smart phones have settings which allow you to store medical history and an emergency contact. Make sure you have supplies needed for caring for your stoma and/or your voice prosthesis as well as extra products. Consider keeping a small bag of everyday products and items ready to take with when going out for short outings, like running errands.

If you are venturing out further than your local area, you may want to schedule some time with your clinician to discuss your trip. Your clinician can provide a

more complete list of recommended items for you to take. You will also want to ask your physician for a prescription so you can be seen by another clinician in case of emergency while you are traveling. Atos can help you to identify clinicians in the area(s) you are traveling, both throughout the US and in other countries you might visit.

You may consider consulting a travel agent regarding your travel plans. Travel professionals should have up-to-date tips about COVID restrictions in different areas. They will also know what destinations are most safe and what safety measures are in place.

The pandemic has also made travel insurance more popular and prudent. Look for something that will provide protection in the event of a cancellation due to local restrictions and also covers medical expenses.

Wherever you may roam, be sure to use common sense and follow local rules for masking and distancing. Also, consider using a heat and moisture exchanger filter (HMEF) such as Provox® Life[™] Protect HME or Provox® Micron[™] HME when you going to crowded or unfamiliar places and especially when using mass transportation. The filter helps to protect you from airborne particles (such as viruses, bacteria, dust and pollen.)* Safe travels!

- Mirror
- Tweezers
- Hand sanitizer
- Pen and paper
- Emergency card/medical bracelet
- Flashlight
- Water soluble lubricant
- Saline bullets
- Cotton-tip applicators (external use only)
- Electrolarynx and charging cord or spare batteries
- HMEs
- Adhesives and/or laryngectomy tubes
- Skin Barrier
- Adhesive Remover
- Cleaning Towel
- Shower aid (for longer outings)
- Additional items if you use a voice prosthesis (VP):
- Brush and Flush for VP
- A back-up VP of your current size/type
- A plug for your VP




